PLATTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – PBG HOTEL AND RESTAURANT SITE DEVELOPMENT EA

The County of Clinton has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed Hotel and Restaurant Site Development project at the Plattsburgh International Airport (PBG). The EA evaluates the environmental, social and economic consequences of the proposed development of a hotel, restaurant, associated parking and access road from Crete Boulevard (CR 22), and associated pedestrian walkway connecting the hotel and Airport Terminal. The project is located east of the Airport Terminal building and parking area and north of Florida Avenue in the city of Plattsburgh.

The EA is available for public review beginning on October 19, 2017 at the Airport Manager's Office at 42 Airport Lane, Suite 201, Plattsburgh, NY 12903, the Clinton County Legislative Offices, 137 Margaret Street, Suite 208, Plattsburgh, NY 12901, on the County's website at <http://www.clintoncountygov.com/Departments/Airport/AirportHome.html> and the airport's website <http://flyplattsburgh.com/About/ImportantDocuments>.

The public comment period will be from October 19 to November 17, 2017. Public comments are welcome on the proposed action, and the potential economic, social, and environmental consequences as well as the project's consistency with the goals and objectives of the affected area's land use or planning strategy.
